Programs

- Hall-Thorpe Sports activities have been developed to address the four developmental movement concepts– Body Awareness, Space Awareness, Effort Awareness, and Relationship Awareness. This also encompasses positive self concepts.
- Hall-Thorpe Sports encourages its staff and children during game time, to use an ecological approach (use environment for stimulus) to encourage cognitive thought processes) stimulus.
- Hall-Thorpe Sports operates from the ethos that children who partake in physical activity, are more likely to see benefits across a range of areas, including physical and psychological well being, and scholastic improvement.
- Hall-Thorpe Sports Outside School Hours Care programs have been designed in response to the increasing rates of obesity in children, ongoing trend of dual income families, and the increasing rates of technology use amongst children.
- All games and activities are developmentally appropriate, and conducted under the supervision of highly skilled and qualified instructors.
- All programs focus on sporting skill development, and aim to ensure that its participants are active during the 'critical window' of opportunity, which is between 3pm and 6pm.

- The program also provides an education component, which teaches children the potential negative impact of cultural industry advertising, and the impact of sedentary activities such as playing computer games and using the Internet.
